From Shelter to Summits -Ariel's Adirondack 46er Journey

Amber Pitcher and her dog Ariel scaled the Adirondack's 46 High Peaks together, dedicating their finish hike as a fundraiser to the Humane Society. She then submitted her story to the Petco Foundation's Holiday Wishes campaign and won a \$10,000 grant for MHHS.

From the moment I saw her blue and brown eyes when I met her at the Humane Society, I knew Ariel had a sense of adventure in her. Together we discovered our love for the mountains, inspiring our dream of becoming Adirondack 46ers. Ariel was 8 years old when we climbed our first mountain and I didn't think it was possible for us to hike all 46 peaks, but we would enjoy some of them while we could.

Along our journey we summited all of the peaks required in two other mountains groups – the Catskill 3500ers and Saranac Lake 6ers. In our spare time Ariel had become a Canine Good Citizen and registered therapy dog.

When Ariel was 10 years old, we embarked on our most challenging hike, the Great Range Traverse, with ladders, cliffs, and over 24 miles of rough terrain. Ariel overcame these obstacles with ease. We raced the setting sun across the exposed summit of Mt. Haystack and I felt an overwhelming sense of freedom. We sat together taking in the magnificence of the Adirondacks and I thought to myself, "This is what it feels like to be fully alive."

Come Ariel's 11th birthday we were over halfway to our goal and she had given me every reason to believe in her and myself. On August 20, 2016, on the summit of Mt. Colden, we became Adirondack 46ers.

From the President and CEO



MHHS President and CEO Brad Shear

The Mohawk Hudson Humane Society was founded in 1887 and one of our first board presidents was named Dr. William O. Stillman. He would become an internationally known icon for animal protection, leading the American Humane Association for over 20 years while continuing to serve as the president of our board. In 1904 Dr. Stillman wrote:

"The corporate history of this Society – from its small beginning up to its evolution into its present form – has been a record of strenuous effort, of triumph over local apathy, of victory over unusual opposition and obstacles, and of final gratifying success and the winning of public confidence. Every victory worth having has been the product of just such faith and struggle."

Dr. Stillman set a high standard for the Society and during his tenure he led the initiative to build the region's first animal shelter on our site in Menands. Over 100 years after the construction of that facility,

it is still standing and in use, but has far outlasted its useful life. For many years we have known the Society's facilities were aging, outdated and have not provided the comfort that homeless animals in our care deserve.

Unfortunately, toward the end of the 20th century the organization did not have the visionary leadership and resources that we had a century earlier, so we could not undertake the tremendous effort needed to replace the facility. Over the last 10 years we have concentrated on building a focused and effective team of board members, staff and volunteers who, with the support of community members, were able to build a solid foundation on which to embark upon the monumental task of funding and building a new Animal Care Center.

I am proud to note that our volunteers and staff have never viewed the inadequacies of our facility as a deterrent or excuse to shy away from providing a high standard of animal care and developing programs and services that were needed for the animals and the community. To make an understatement, they have learned to do more with less. I am excited about what we will accomplish when we do not have the limitations of a poor facility holding us back.

As Dr. Stillman said: "The Mohawk and Hudson River Humane Society ... from very humble beginnings has succeeded in accomplishing very wonderful results for the good of the helpless wards of society within its jurisdiction."

Great things take time and the Society's time has come. I thank all who have placed their trust in us, persevered through the hard times, and believed in our vision. Great things are coming and we will continue to need the support of everyone who has helped us create a better life for animals.

On September 20, MHHS leaders, staff, volunteers and supporters gathered for a cermonial groundbreaking to mark the start of construction of the new Animal Care Center.

WTEN Chief Meteorologist and Honorary Chair for the building campaign said, "Think about the hundreds of thousands of pets that have come through those doors over the years and have been given a second chance at life. And now it's going to be even better. This is going to be a place where we will want to visit, to spend time, to help and to make a difference. It's going to be absolutely unbelievable."

MHHS President & CEO Brad Shear noted, "When we look at our community and see how caring people are and how important animals are and we look at the facility we have, it's not an accurate reflection. Soon we will have a new place that is a true reflection of how caring our community really is."

A capital campaign for \$7.2M began over the summer and more than half of the needed funds have been raised. Society Board Chair Miguel Berger encouraged all members of our community to bring the project to fruition and support it with a financial gift. "Large or small, every gift brings us closer to a better community for the animals and those who love them," said Berger.


Our current facilities are continuing to operate while construction is underway. The projected completion is summer 2017.

Caring for Pets When You're No Longer There

Pets are part of our family. So what happens if they outlive us? According to Loudonville-based trust and estate attorney Stephen Buckley, "First, owners should figure out who will care for their pets after they have passed away. Equally important is to ensure the animals will continue to live a lifestyle to which they have become accustomed."

The easiest way is to bequeath pets to a specific person. It's very important to inform that person of your intentions in advance. Too often, pets end up in a shelter because these intentions were not adequately communicated. You may also want to consider leaving a fixed sum of money to cover essential needs, such as food, veterinary care and grooming.

Another option is to set up a trust specifically for the care of your pet. A trust defines a sum of money to be managed by a trustee for the benefit of the animal. This situation is perfect for those who do not have anyone to take on the care of their animals. The trustee would be responsible for finding a good home and ensuring they are receiving all they need for the remainder of their lives.
