OUR mission

The mission of the Mohawk & Hudson River Humane Society is to improve the lives of homeless and abused animals through sheltering, adoption, education, advocacy and the prevention of animal cruelty.

The Society has been providing shelter for lost, abused and unwanted animals since 1887. Our animal care facility is the largest in the Capital Region, serving an average of 7,000 animals per year.



To carry out our work for the animals,
The Society receives no ongoing funding
from federal, state or local governments or
any national animal welfare organization.
We rely on your generous donations to
support our vital services for the animals.

Our doors are open to orphaned animals
in need. We receive not just common
household pets like cats, dogs, rabbits and
hamsters, but also snakes, birds, iguanas,
fish, horses, livestock and even llamas.

OUR services



Pet Adoption: The Society finds more homes for animals than any other agency in the Capital Region. Adopted animals are spayed or neutered, dewormed, vaccinated for rabies and distemper, and treated for fleas. Dogs are tested for heartworm and cats for feline leukemia. Each adopted pet come with 30 days of free pet insurance. Our website has a live feed to our available pets, constantly updated as animals arrive and are adopted.

Cruelty Investigation: If you are concerned an animal is being abused or neglected, please contact us. Our staff will work with local law enforcement to investigate and protect animals in harm's way.

Animal Surrender: When members of the community can no longer care for their pets, they can be brought to our facility where we will make every effort to find them a new home and family.

Safe Haven: When women flee abusive homes, we will house their pets for free while they are in a women's shelter. We work with our community partners to educate the public about the connection between animal abuse and domestic violence.

Microchipping: A microchip is a small electronic device placed under the skin. Once registered, this chip helps to reunite you with your pet if it is ever lost.





Humane Education:

We visit schools, nursing homes and other groups to talk about various issues affecting our community's animals and their owners, such as the importance of spaying and neutering.

Volunteer Opportunities:

We're proud to have a dedicated group of volunteers who contribute their time and talent to our beloved animals. Whether it's walking dogs, socializing with the cats, fostering kittens, sorting bottles or organizing fundraisers, we couldn't do our valuable work without YOU!

K9 Memorial: The Society's grounds feature one of the few police K9 memorials in the United States.

Dog Training: Our certified dog trainer will help you teach your dog manners and solve behavior problems. Classes are enrolling now!

Disaster Response: The Society's efforts are an official part of the disaster response plans for Albany and Rensselaer Counties. When disaster strikes, we work to evacuate animals and ensure that they can be cared for until they are reunited with their families.
